### About The Charity

Founded in 1999 in memory of the late Dr Martin Lawrence, The Lawrence Home Nursing Team provides excellent holistic care for end of life patients who wish to remain within their home environment. Based in Chipping Norton, and registered with the Care Quality Commission (rating of good), the service is provided in the local area by a team of dedicated nurses who work in partnership with the patient, their family, carers and the healthcare services in the area.

### About The Role

The Registered Nurse Manager plays a pivotal role in overseeing that the charity maintains the high clinical and professional standards it is renowned for. Supported by a Clinical Director, the role ensures that the services offered are safe, effective, caring, responsive and well led. Leading on Governance, risk assessment and management, the Registered Nurse Manager influences the culture and ethos of the charity and helps to support the patients' and families' palliative care experience. Working primarily from the Chipping Norton Office with some homeworking, no two days are the same making this an interesting and rewarding role.

### The post holder will be required to ensure that:

- The nursing team operates to defined clinical standards and that it meets its objectives. This includes the requirements of professional registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) and the professional standards outlined within the NMC Code.
- Safe working practices are developed and implemented particularly those relating to health and safety at work.
- A culture of quality is embedded within LHNT and that clinical governance and risk management are implemented.
- Leadership, co-ordination, and line management for LHNT is provided within the agreed scope of the service. Specifically, this includes line management to the LHNT Coordinators and LHNT Clinical Team.
- The service delivery is developed in response to changing patient need, local healthcare design and available resource.
